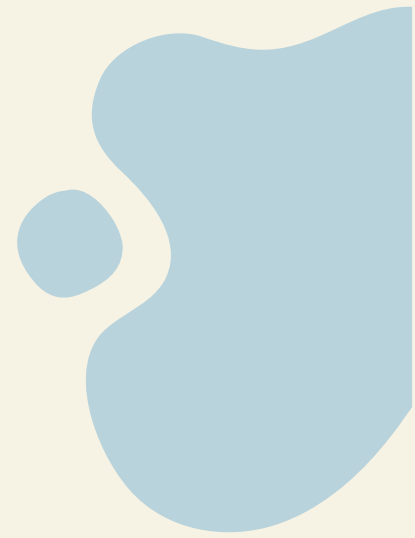

- Most MS have started to analyze actions -> which organizations in MS are responsible for actions
- Different countries have different contexts: depending on countries different actions and strategies might need to be high-lighted
- Part of MS have prepared national monitoring scheme
- There was agreement that we should cooperate and organise further exchanges on many of the targets. Examples:
 - establishing the list of typical pollinator species per habitat type,
 - new monitoring techniques,
 - Opportunities in the frame of LIFE Integrated projects or LIFE SNAPs
 - Possible financing sources

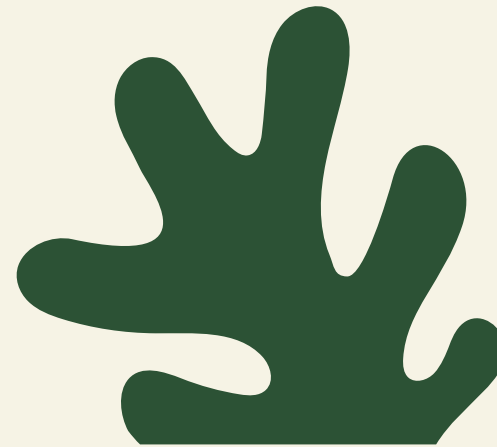
