Mission 1 - Support and training

In order to enhance the units marine environment competences, CACEM enables enforcement units to keep abreast of current regulations and national/regional/local objectives thanks to a wide range of operational tools available on its LégiCEM website. The environmental themes covered in this police work concern a wide range of activities, such as work in the marine environment, protected species disturbance, harmful anchoring and unauthorised careening.



A Nationwide and inter-administration competency

A multi-expertise centre : jurists, biologists, data analysts, geomatics specialists and experienced field agents.

Mission 2 - Guidance and coordination

The CACEM's role is to efficiently allocate the efforts onto the French coastguard units, which is composed of specialized administrations, the Navy, Customs, Maritime Affairs, the OFB, the Gendarmerie and many others, based on ecological needs, control units availability, reports of suspected infringements and control history. Before, during and after a mission, the CACEM's team is able to respond to requests from control units for legal, operational or biodiversity backups. To accomplish this mission, the CACEM uses Monitor Env, a state-owned software package developed through an agile iterations process, as well as the LégiCEM's corpus and the missions' history database hosted on Metabase.

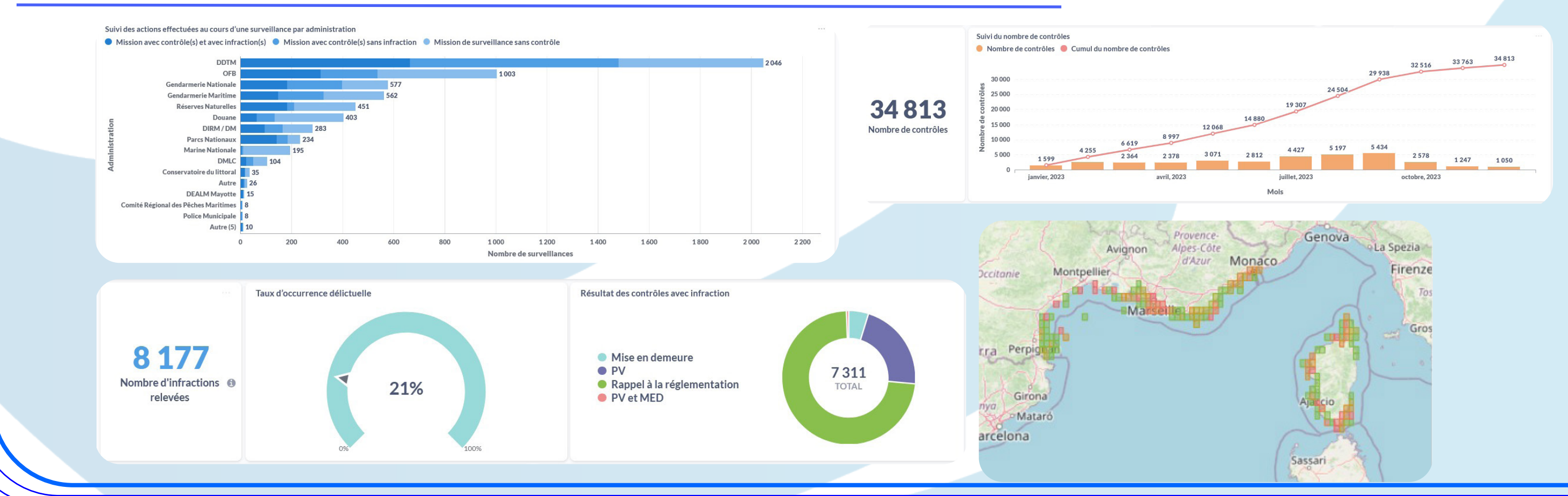


Over **5,000** missions and **35,000** controls supports by the CACEM.

Mission 3 - Analysis and statistics



The data reported by the control units, after being entered into Monitor Env by the CACEM's team, can be viewed in customized dashboards on Metabase. This enables the units and their administrations to monitor their activity and their growing expertise in marine environmental policing. It also saves a considerable amount of time in drawing up activity reports.

The data enable the CACEM to accumulate intelligence on controls effectiveness (spatialized infringement rate, number of missions, versatility of units, etc.). Match analyses between enforcement effort and ecological needs will help prioritize and size appropriately environmental public policy.
