


PA CRITERIA (30 %/ 10 %) AND THEIR CONTEXT

<u>30 %</u>:

all of our PAs specified in Nature and Landscape Protection act comply categories differ in their overall concept and/or purpose new planned (national) PAs mostly overlap with existing Natura 2000 sites tools that are not sensu stricto PAs can be further developed

<u>10 %</u>:

National Parks and Protected Landscape Areas – zoning needs to be considered (or even greater detail needs to be applied)

Small-scale PAs – their legal conservation tools are fit for purpose


